THE STORE WAS STOCKED WITH GROCERIES, GENERAL SUPPLIES AND DRYGOODS. THEIR RESIDENCE IN THE BACK OF THE STORE MADE SIGRUN AND PAUL READILY AVAILABLE TO SERVE THEIR CUSTOMERS. SIGRUN'S KNOWLEDGE OF DRESSMAKING CAME IN HANDY FOR ADVICE ON STYLE OR FABRIC AND SOMETIMES SHE WOULD BE EMPLOYED TO SEW THE GARMENT.
